## James O. Donnelly

James ("Jim") O. Donnelly is the President and CEO of Wayne Bank and Norwood Financial Corp.

Donnelly began this role in May of 2022, and serves on the Board of Directors for Wayne Bank and Norwood Financial Corp, in addition to being a member of the Leadership, Officers Loan, Asset Quality, ALCO, and 401K Committees.

He was previously employed by Bangor Savings Bank in Maine for eight years, where Donnelly was the Executive Vice President and Chief Commercial Officer. Donnelly served in the  $115^{th}$  to  $118^{th}$  Maine Legislatures, leading his caucus as Minority Leader in the House in the  $118^{th}$  Maine Legislature. He was the youngest member elected to the  $115^{th}$  Legislature and the youngest Legislative Leader in the Country in the  $118^{th}$  Legislature.

He earned a B.A. from the University of Maine at Presque Isle and his M.B.A. from Post University. Donnelly is also a graduate of the New England School

of Banking at Williams College and the American Community Bankers National School for Senior Management at Villanova University.

During Donnelly's first year leading Wayne Bank, the financial institution reentered the Russell 2000 Index®. Under his leadership in that same year, the Bank was also ranked one of the *Top 25 Best Banks in the U.S.* and one of the *Top 10 banks in the \$2B - \$5B Asset Size Category* by *Bank Director Magazine*. *American Banker* also included Wayne Bank in its list of *Top 200 Banks in the \$2B to \$10B Asset Size Category*.
